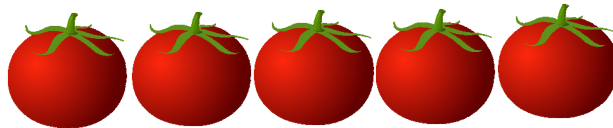

Some of the duties of this position are answering phones, ordering office and church supplies, assisting parishioners, scheduling and attending church functions, etc... Our Lady of Prompt Succor School has several job openings for the 2018-2019 School Year:

1. Full-Time Certified Educational Counselor for Elementary School. This person will work the same hours as teachers (7:30 AM to 3:15 PM, Monday through Friday) during the school year. This is a 10-month position. The counselor will work closely with the administrative team and faculty in implementing a nurturing environment favorable to faith formation and learning, establish effective rapport with students, and good relationships with teachers and parents. In addition, the counselor will provide individualized as well as small and large group programs to meet the needs of the students. This may include classroom visits, individual counseling of students, and evening programs for parents. A degree in education counseling with experience in elementary education is preferred. Interested candidates should submit a cover letter and resume to Annette Accomando, aaccomando@olpsschool.org no later than **June 8, 2018**.

2. Full-Time Receptionist (12 month position). This position is mainly responsible for greeting all visitors and answering the phone. Additionally, this person assists with recording daily attendance, especially tardies, and checking students in and out. Also, this person may create the monthly lunch calendars, the monthly Christian Awards, and assures all student immunizations are up-to-date. This is a five days a week, 8 hours per day position. A college degree with experience using computers is preferred. 4. Part-Time Human Resources Personnel (12 month position). This qualified candidate will have experience in HR and, preferably, an HR degree. This position is responsible for assuring all aspects of HR are completed in a timely manner including benefits, time sheets, and payroll. This is a 20-hour per week position. 5. First Grade Teacher. The teacher in this role will create a nurturing classroom environment favorable to learning and faith formation in a Catholic setting, establish effective rapport with students, motivate students to develop skills, attitudes and knowledge needed to provide a good foundation in accordance with each child's ability, and establish good relationships with parents. Additionally, the teacher will develop lesson plans and instructional material and provide individualized and small group instruction to adapt the curriculum to the needs of each student, integrate technology into daily instruction, and establish and maintain standards of student behavior to achieve an effective learning environment. 6. Part-Time Administrative Assistant (11 month position). This qualified candidate will have a minimum of five years experience in education with an education degree and certification.
