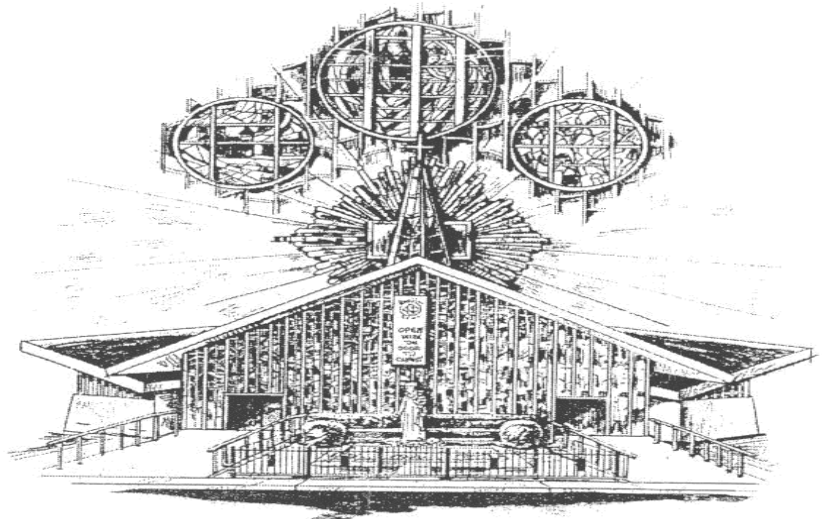

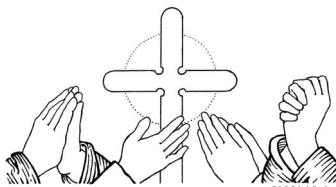
Dear Friends,

When I first came back to New Orleans from Alabama eight years ago, some of my friends from Alabama called and asked me, "How is it? Do you like it there?" "Yes, I feel like home here (home away from home)." I said, "only thing is that it takes little time for me to get to know the people and the area (Chalmette) here. This is the city of New Orleans, I used to live in for twelve years when I first came to the United States from Vietnam. Chalmette was an unfamiliar area to me as I had lived on the West Bank," I explained.

After two years, I am in love with people at Our Lady of Prompt Succor. Different from Alabama where there is a very small percentage of Catholics, Chalmette is predominately Catholic. Wherever I go either Walmart, restaurants or car wash in the area people (often I do not recognize) are waiving and saying, "Hello Father!" That means a lot to me.

And so, it is not easy to say goodbye to the wonderful brothers and sisters whom I love reverently though I have been frequently moving in the past. To remember my mom's teachings: Say Thanks to those who do good for you and say sorry when you make a mistake. It is time for me to remember to say thanks to all of you for your love and support that make me feel so welcomed here. At the same time, I would like to ask for your forgiveness for my inadequacies of whatever I might have done or said in offending any of you. Life will go on as I move to St. Mary Magdalen with a new parish and new people. The people of Our Lady of Prompt Succor will always be in special place in my heart and in my daily prayers.

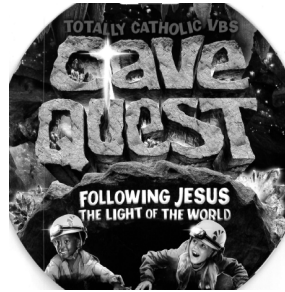
