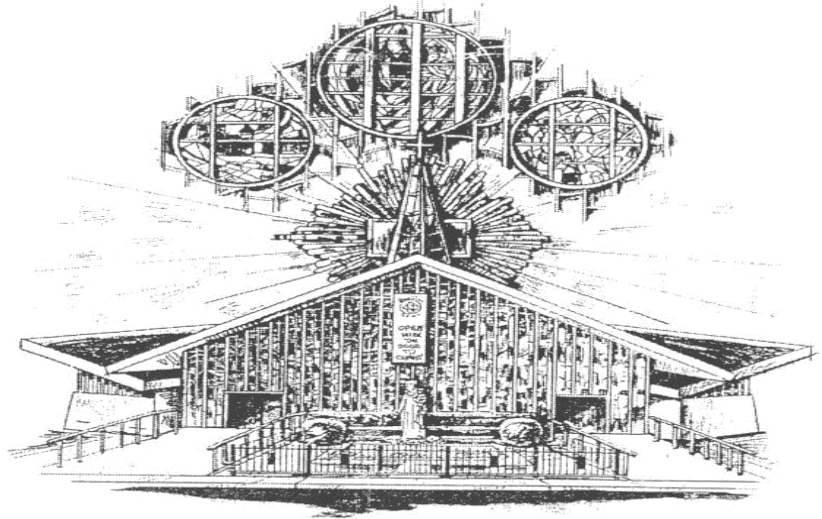

Dear Friends:

I want to thank all the Ushers and Lectors who attended a liturgy seminar and prayer service this past Saturday to help us celebrate our masses well. A similar gathering was held for the Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist on Nov. 19. We have some new members and a good number attended. I hope that more people will join them in serving in the future. I have been making phone calls to invite parishioners to participate in these ministries and others. I thank those who have agreed to serve in these ways as well as on the committees for the Synod on Social Justice, Family Life, Vocations, and Evangelization. The archdiocese is beginning to train the leaders of these committees but you can still be added to the committee if you are interested. The activities will begin next year.

This coming week some members of our parish from the Hispanic Community and Pacific Islander Community will celebrate special masses for their groups. On Sunday, Dec. 11 the Hispanics will celebrate the feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe. All are invited to attend the Spanish language mass at 2 pm and then follow in a procession to the cafeteria to a dinner and entertainment. The Filipino group will celebrate a special mass for Christmas time on Friday, Dec. 16 at 6 pm in the Church followed by a dinner social in the cafeteria. The Hispanics will also celebrate the Posadas on Friday, Dec. 23 at 7 pm in the cafeteria. Come and experience a different culture and meet some new friends from our parish and beyond.

Also plan to attend the celebration of our parish patroness Our Lady of Prompt Succor, on Saturday, Jan. 7 at the 4 pm mass. Afterward we will process with a statue to the cafeteria for a short prayer service and a dinner dance. Food from area restaurants will be served.
