We welcome you with great joy and invite you to register and worship with us regularly. Census forms are at all exits.

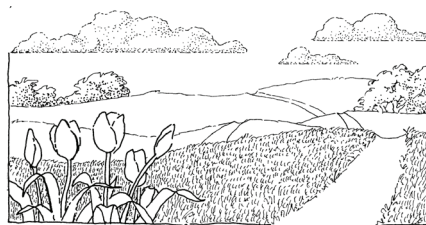
